Laurence dropped out of school in the early 1970's and while travelling the world he was confronted with the love of Christ through members of the Jesus People movement, who subsequently led him to the Lord. He is the author of *Sowing Reaping Keeping*, *Loving the Lost* and *Beyond the Clouds*.
